Egyptian Nemes

What are they?

Nemes were worn by Pharaohs in Ancient Egypt. They covered the whole crown, back of the head and nape of the neck. They were considered a symbol of royalty.

What do the designs feature?

Nemes included a striped design with colours of blue and gold. They sometimes included an Ancient Egyptian God or animal (such as a snake) in the centre of the Neme.

Some interesting facts are...

A Neme was designed to symbolize the Pharaoh's power. When a Pharaoh's sarcophogus was designed, it included their head or face wearing a Neme.
