

Our new topic

Our topic for this half term is called 'Can we explore it?' The project will capture the children's natural curiosity



about the world around them through the use of their senses. We will do this through lots of child initiated activities and sensory and imaginative play. We will also be looking at different ways of travelling, journeys and adventures. In Maths, we have been working on the recognition and identification of 2D shapes. We will be moving on to recognising numerals and matching them to quantities correctly.

Letters & Sounds

The children have been identifying sounds in the environment and have been working hard to understand the concept of rhyme and alliteration. They are now beginning to hear and recognize initial sounds in words. We are encouraging the children to listen for sounds in words by playing simple games such as 'I Spy' or simple communication and listening games like 'Simon Says'.
