Lexia programme £4000	All children in receipt of PP in KS2 will benefit from being able to access the Lexia programme at home and at school	Every child made accelerated progress and exceed the months progress compared to the timescale.
Teaching assistant maths focus group for year 3 and 4 every morning £3000	Small focus group for maths every morning for PP children	All PP children within the group made accelerated progress. Having the additional member of staff also reduced the class size for the other children, which enabled a small pupil teacher ratio.
Additional teaching assistant for EYFS £16'000	Autumn term – full time in EYFS with a focus on EYPP  Spring and Summer term – 3 x afternoon additional reading in KS1	Additional Teaching Assistant enabled focus time for PP children within Reception.
