### Suggested activities to fill your daily timetable

Reading	Handwriting	Writing
Please continue to read 4x a week.  Continue reading and writing the cvcc words attached and the ccvc words. Look, say, cover, write and check.	To practise forming the letters 'q' and 'g'	We're Going on a Bear Hunt – after reading the story, can you change any parts to make your own version?  Write a sentence with one of the cvcc/ccvc words attached.
Number	PE	Creative
Add 2 groups of objects together and write the addition sum. E.g. add 2 sets of sweets together $6+3=9$ . Attempt to add them together by keeping the biggest number in your head and counting on.	Try and keep active daily. You can join in with Joe Wicks live stream PE sessions on Youtube.	Re-create the lifecycle of a frog/ chicken/ duck/ butterfly.  See scavenger hunt attached.
