Welcome to Reception! We would like to introduce you to the Reception team.

Our priority over the next few weeks is settling the children in and we will start the term by discussing school rules and routines and learning in the different areas of the classroom.

Our first topic is called 'Did dragons exist?'. We will start this topic in week 3. We will be sharing many stories about castles and dragons, exploring castle life and lots more!

In Reception we will consolidate Phase 2 letters and sounds from Nursery. Your child will learn about sounds and words every day and we will provide a range of relevant activities in the classroom to consolidate their learning. As we would like the children to settle in effectively we will not be starting Phonics until week 3.

From the 7th September your child will bring home a school reading book along with a log book to record when they have read at home. A signature and comment is all that is required, we do not expect a full book to be read in one night.

In Maths, we will be using many ways to practise counting, ordering and forming numbers. The children will have the opportunity to see 2D shapes around the school environment, become familiar with their names and describe them.

The children will now be attending Celebration Assembly on a Friday. Every week we select a 'Star of the week' from each class. The children will need to do the following to be eligible:

- Read 4 times at home
- Follow Golden Rules
- Wear correct uniform
- Have full attendance
