



KS2 Home Reading

The expectation is that **every child reads a minimum of four times per week to/with an adult** at home. There is a helpful KS2 guide to help parents with reading at home on the website.

Home reads should be **logged** in the child's Reading Record book.

Every time the child reads at home, they get a sticker on the class chart. Regardless of how many times in one day a child reads at home, they can only receive one sticker for the day.

The reading chart is displayed in the classroom.

Termly Reading Targets

Autumn Term: 50 reads

Spring Term: 100 reads

Summer Term: 150 reads

Once the termly deadline for each target has passed, 50, 100 and 150 reads are not rewarded.

When each milestone is reached, children are sent to Mrs Watson so that they can choose a **book** and she can issue a **certificate**; these will then be **presented** to the children in the **Friday Celebration Assembly**.
