Our topic for the half term is 'Why do you love me so much?' We will be looking at our families, friendships and the things we like to do together, as well as what makes us special.

Please complete some of the homework choices below during Autumn 1 and bring them into school to share with the rest of the class. Tasks can be completed in a variety of ways - be as creative as you like!

Here are some ideas:

<p>Can you make your face using resources around your house?</p> 	<p>Share a favourite story with a grown up. Why do you like this story? Have you got a favourite character? You could tell us about your favourite story at school.</p>	<p>With help from an adult, make a simple shopping list including some of the things you like to eat and drink at home. Draw pictures of the food as part of your list.</p>
<p>Draw a picture that shows all of the people who are special to you. Count how many people you have drawn and then count this number on your fingers.</p>	<p>Why do you love me so much?</p> 	<p>Talk to an adult at home about what you would like to be when you grow up. Can you find out some information about that job to share with the class?</p>
<p>Help a sibling with their homework and take photos to share with the class.</p>	<p>Use some paint to make handprints of everyone's hands in your family. Can you cut out the handprints and find the biggest and smallest handprint? (If you haven't got paint, you could draw around your hands instead)</p>	<p>Can you think of any counting songs to practise numbers 0 to 5? You could try singing the song, '5 little speckled frogs', '5 little ducks' or '1, 2, 3, 4, 5'</p>
