Our topic this half-term is 'Where does the snow go?' We will be looking at seasonal changes, the winter months and arctic animals.

Please complete some of the homework choices below during Autumn 2 and bring them into school to share with the rest of the class. Tasks can be completed in a variety of ways - be as creative as you like!

Here are some ideas:

Draw a picture which shows what you like best about winter time.	Find out what the word 'hibernate' means. With help from an adult, can you list some animals which go into hibernation during the winter months?	During winter it's Christmas! Ask an adult to help you create a countdown calendar to count how many days are left until Christmas Day!
During the next few weeks, go for a 'winter walk'. Can you see anything which suggests the seasons are changing? What does it feel like outside? What can you see?	Where does the snow go? 	Some animals live in cold places around the world. Draw a picture of an animal that lives in a cold place and find out a fact to share with the class about your chosen animal.
Learn some festive songs and spend some time singing with your friends and family.
