Can you write the order of yours and draw pictures to go with it	What might you eat before bed to help your body relax and grow? Design your own supper in your book.
We love to get cosy before bedtime and read a special bedtime story. Choose your favourite story for bedtime to read with your grown up. Can you find out who is the author and the illustrator?	We love to be creative in Reception and make things out of junk. Can you make your very own planet or star.	During this topic we will be learning about nocturnal animals, these are animals that sleep during the day. Make a fact file or poster about a nocturnal animal of your choice.	Collect 2 sets of objects (eg, sweets, pens, lego) and add them together. You could even try and write the addition sum using the addition and equals signs.
