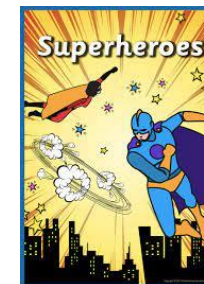


Year 2 Project Homework Superheroes – Spring Term 1

How did she save people?</p>	<p>Choose a hero and a villain from your favourite film or show. Create a table to compare their characteristics and traits.</p>
