

Reception Project Homework – Do Cows Drink Milk?

Spring Term 2

Our topic this term is called ‘Do Cows Drink Milk?’ We will be looking at life cycles of a range of animals that come from eggs, animals and their young and we will be having our very own hatching experience! We will also be discussing the season of Spring.



<p>Empty an eggshell and put some wet cotton wool in the bottom. Then sprinkle some cress seeds on top and watch what happens. Make sure to keep you cress seeds wet. You could use this in an egg sandwich.</p>	<p>Share a story together about a farm animal.</p>	<p>Choose one animal that comes from an egg, then draw and label its life cycle.</p>	<p>How many farm animals can you move like? You could send us a video on dojo.</p>
<p>Write a list of how many animals you may find living on a farm. How many animals can you think of? Discuss which animal you think would be the heaviest. You could even put them in order.</p>	<p>Go on a spring walk. What can you see? Write a list of all of the changes that happen in Spring. Draw a picture to go with it. Encourage your child to listen to the sounds they can hear and write them down.</p>	<p>Go on a 3D shape hunt around your house. What can you find? Sort them into different piles, e.g, spheres, cylinders, cubes, cuboids. With an adult, you could maybe look inside your kitchen cupboards.</p>	<p>Find out what this season is called. Can you make a weather chart for the week and look at the different changes in weather.</p>
