Draw a story map of all the amazing parts of the world they saw.</p>	<p>Visit a local seaside town. Can you list all the human (beach hut, pier and lighthouse) and physical features (sea, coast and cliff) you can see?</p>	<p>Create a fact file about your favourite sea creature including facts about what they look like, where they live and what they eat.</p>
