

## Project homework – Towers, Tunnels and Turrets – Spring 2



Our topic this term is called 'Towers, Tunnels and Turrets'. We will be learning all about different castles, traditional fairytales (plus those with a bit of a twist!) and exploring everyday materials to make structures of our own!

Create a story map of your favourite fairytale story. Or perhaps create a new version of a known fairytale. How is it different?	Look around your house and notice the materials things are made out of. Can you use scientific language to describe the properties of the materials you find? You can use words such as smooth, rough, hard, bendy.	Find on globe all of the continents.  How would you get there? Talk to your grown ups and discuss what it is like on that continent.	Create some artwork using primary and secondary colours. Explore how you can make a range of colours by mixing paints. We would love to see your artwork!
Make an information book about castles, bridges or tunnels. Include downloaded images, as well as drawings and diagrams. What fascinating facts can you find out to amaze your family, friends and teacher?	Make a detailed diagram of a castle, labelling interesting features which might be found inside, or out. Perhaps you could find out about murder holes, garderobes or loopholes?	We are beginning to see some signs of Spring! Go for a walk with your family and make a list of all the signs of Spring you can see.	Play a tumbling tower game such as Jenga, with your family. What are the best ways of keeping the tower upright? See if you can take some action shots or videos of the tower falling!
