With your grown up do some research about marching bands. Can you find out about all of the commands they use? Direct your family as your own marching band. We would love to see!	Find out if there are any bands playing in your local area that you could go and see. Do they use any instruments? Can you name them?	Do some research on drums from other countries. Draw a picture of your favourite, locate its country of origin on a world map and watch a video of someone playing it.	Record some sounds at home and make your own sound quiz! What about the sound of the washing machine, the sound of your favourite programme or the sound of your pet. Then test your family to see if they can tell you what the sound is.
Design a uniform for a marching band. Look at pictures online for inspiration.	Design and make your own musical instrument using recycling from around your house. Think carefully about the materials you use. You could test the sounds they make before you get started.	Write a fact file on your favourite musician. Learn all about their childhood, their inspiration and accomplishments.	Create your own dance routine to a song you like. Send us a video over Dojo to share with the class.
