

## Year 3 Summer 1 Blue Abyss News Letter



We hope you all had a lovely Easter and a well-deserved rest. The Year 3 team are very excited to dive into our new topic and explore the deep, dark, depths of the Blue Abyss! This is a heavily based art and music topic that will provide your child the opportunity to explore different artistic techniques and music styles.

## Engage Day

The children will be using different Art medias including: collage, painting and sketching to create their very own under water scene as well as learning about Coral Reefs and the sea life that lives within them.

**English:** Our writing will focus on informative texts and poetry. These will include areas such as: The Great Barrier Reef, how to help keep our ocean clean and how to keep endangered species safe.

Guided Reading: We will be continuing to learn about how to make inferences from pieces of text as well as making predictions, summaries and retrieving facts. The children will also be able to learn about Jacques Cousteau, a deep sea diver and inventor.

Maths: The children will be learning about division, which will then give them a good foundation to understand fractions which will be covered at the end of the half-term. Please note, the children need to keep revising their 3, 4 and 8 times tables as they need to know these by the end of the year.

**Science:** We will be looking at light in particular how shadows are formed. Lessons will be inspired around the famous 'Another Place' sculpture by Antony Gormley.

## Reminders

Homework: Given every Thursday consisting of Spelling and Maths or English. The children also have project homework for this half term that they can complete and bring into school for our lovely homework display.

Reading: Children should be reading at least four times per week at home. This can be their school book or books of choice at home. Please record each time your child reads at home in their planner. Packed lunches: These should include a well-balanced mixture of savoury and sweet. Sweets or fizzy drinks should not be included. No packed lunches should contain nuts, peanut butter sandwiches or Nutella sandwiches, due to allergies in school.
