Take photos and tell us what you liked and disliked.	Do a portrait or model of a mythical character with an interesting appearance, e.g. Cyclops, Medusa or the Minotaur. You could even use a range of materials to give it 3D look.	Build your own Mount Olympus - home to the Greek Gods - out of cardboard, a bottle and newspaper or even Lego! 
Write your own myth with your creature as a main character. Think about its personality and where it lives, before developing a story that contains lots of features of myths.	Gods and Mortals!
