Design a part-man, part-beast mythical creature. Which animal body parts will it have?	Do a portrait or model of a mythical character with an interesting appearance, e.g. Cyclops, Medusa or the Minotaur. You could even use a range of materials to give it 3d look.	Build your own Mount Olympus - home to the Greek Gods - out of cardboard, a bottle and newspaper or even Lego!	THINK OF YOUR OWN IDEA
Find out about the first Olympic games in Athens. How does it differ to the modern Olympics?	Gods and Mortals!	Write your own myth with your creature as a main character. Think about its personality and where it lives, before developing a story that contains lots of features of myths.	Taste some traditional Greek food such as moussaka, goat's cheese, figs or taramasalata. Take photos and tell me what you liked and disliked.

Make your own model of it or present a fact page showing your research.	Research the different ancient Greek Gods and create a poster or PowerPoint. What were they God of?
