Research the timeline of ancient Egypt, and create your own! Include key dates, events, images and illustrations.



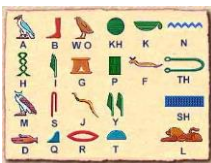
Research famous Egyptian rulers and pharaohs – like Cleopatra. Design your own 2-D or 3-D Egyptian style jewellery.



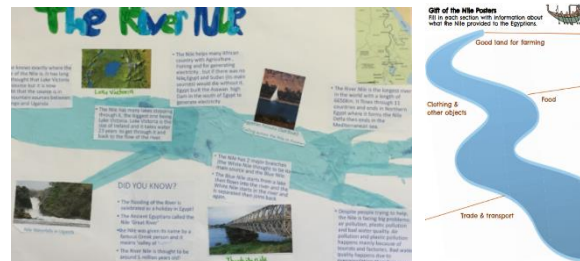
