

## **Year 6 Spelling Shed Schedule: Autumn 2, 2021-22**

Spelling Shed is proven to be incredibly effective, due to its engaging, interactive and repetitive nature. It is recommended that children play the games for 15-20 minutes per day, at least 3 days per week.

In the event that your child is unable to access Spelling Shed, the weekly spellings are included below. Copying the spellings out in cursive handwriting as many times as possible throughout the week will help to commit them to memory.

In Year 6, we introduce the spellings to the children on Mondays. We then teach spelling at intervals through the week, followed by a small test on Friday mornings. The test is to inform future teaching and all we ask is that children try their best.
